Calculate cubic feet of space to be treated: Close all doors and windows. Spray in a sweeping motion on all parts of the room. Apply for 2-3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet of space. Do not remain in treated areas. Vacate premises for at least 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate the area after treatment is completed and before re-entering. Remove pets, bits and cover lish aquariums before spraying. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. For spiders and silverfish: For control of these insects, frequent and repeated spraying of baseboards, windows, door frames, b. okcases, and storage areas should be made. For adequate control, spray directly on insects.

For crickets: Spray thoroughly and frequently behind stoves, refrigerators, under cabinets, in food storage areas, and especially in closets, basements, and other damp areas. For best results, spray directly on insects.

For ante: Spray ant trails, nests and points of entry.
