This statement must be placed on the front panel, immediately below the ingredient statement and must appear in the same type size as that which is required for the signal word following the child hazard precautionary statement.

- b. The registration number which has been assigned to this product must appear on the label as EPA Reg. No. 11561-8.

4. You will submit five copies of finished printed labels before you release the product for shipment, as required by P.R. Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982. The finished printed labels are those under which you will market the product, and they must also comply with the general labeling requirements of 40 CFR 162.10. This product will kill Fleas, Flies, Mosquitoes, Black Carpet Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Spiders, Centipedes, Ticks, Wasps, Pill Bugs, Chiggers and Silverfish.
Aids in control of Cockroaches.

TO KILL TICKS: Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Apply this product as for other insects. Put fresh bedding in pets quarters after treatment. Treat dogs and cats with a registered tick control product before allowing them to enter.

Cover exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

TO KILL FLEAS: Follow directions for Ticks; but use one can per 1,500 cubic feet.

CAUTION: May cause discoloration to carpets, asphalt tile and some plastics may be affected by this product. Place newspapers on asphalt tile before treatment and cover plastic items, such as plastic furniture, stereo covers, eye glasses, etc.
