Subject: Labeling Amendment Submitted in Response to  
PR Notice 87-6  
EPA Registration Number 11561-11

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the following comments.

1. Replace "3-Phenoxybenzyl d-cis and trans \*\* 2,2-dimethyl-3-(2-methylpropenyl) cyclopropane carboxylate" with "d-cis and trans 3-phenoxybenzyl- (1RS, 3RS; 1RS, 3SR) -2,2-dimethyl-3-(2-methylprop-1-enyl) cyclopropanecarboxylate" and remove "cis/trans isomer ratio: max 25% (+ or -) cis min 75% (+ or -) trans" and "Other isomers ..... .007%" from the ingredients statement on the label. The percent phenothrin declared on the label should be .356% instead of .343%.

2. Delete the statement "Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia." from the Statement of Practical Treatment.

3. Add the statement "Get medical attention if irritation persists." to the If on Skin section in the Statement of Practical Treatment. Also use this statement to replace the statement "Call a physician immediately." in the If in Eyes section.

4. Delete "In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water, and "exposed" from the Warnings to "Humans and Domestic Animals" section.

5. Replace the existing Physical or Chemical Hazards statements with "Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above degrees F may cause

6. Delete "Caution" from the statements concerning possible discoloration to carpets, etc. and move these statements to the Physical or Chemical Hazards section.

7. Add the statement "Remove or cover food before treatment." before the statement "Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying."

8. Replace the Environmental Hazard Statements with "This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters."

A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records. Submit five (5) copies of the final printed labeling.
