FIRE HAZARD— DO NOT SPRAY INTO OR NEAR FIRE OR OPEN FLAME. DO NOT SMOKE WHILE SPRAYING.

Harmful if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid breathing spray mist. In case of contact with skin, wash with soap and water. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not use in commercial food preparation areas or in edible products areas of food processing plants. Do not reuse empty container. When container is empty, immediately wash thoroughly, then destroy by perforating or crushing and burying in a safe place.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Roaches and Waterbugs: Apply as a coarse, wet spray or by the use of a paint brush. Treat only infested cracks, surfaces or other areas where the insects rest, run or hide. Thoroughly spray or paint infested cracks and other hiding places and adjacent exposed surfaces when they come out of hiding.

Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Ants: Thoroughly spray or paint trails and crevices around door sills and window frames where ants may enter. It is also desirable to treat the openings around water pipes, air ducts, electrical outlets, and baseboards where they may come into rooms from wall spaces and partitions. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Carpet Beetles: Thoroughly spray or paint infested areas of carpets, localized areas of floors and baseboards, and into the cracks and under carpets where the insects may be found. Localized treatments of areas on floors, baseboards and shelves of closets may also be effective. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Houseflies, Wasps and Mosquitoes: Indoors — Apply thorough and repeated spraying or painting to selected surfaces such as doors, around windows and areas frequented by these insects. Outdoors — thoroughly spray or paint screens, window frames, doorsills and selected crevices of porches. Repeated applications are essential outdoors.

Spiders and Centipedes: Thoroughly spray infested baseboards and corners, also pipes, storage localities and other infested areas in basements. Repeat as often as necessary to maintain effective control.

Scorpions: Thoroughly spray or paint around door sills, window frames or other areas where these insects may enter. Frequent repeated applications may be necessary, particularly on exterior surfaces exposed to the weather.

Silverfish: Thoroughly spray or paint baseboards, areas behind shelving, book cases and storage areas. Repeat as often as necessary for effective control.
