Algitrol is a concentrate and should be diluted before using.

When Algitrol is used as directed, it will control the growth of chlorella pyrenoiddosa enoiddosa (green), Phormidium inundatum(black algae), Phormidium retzii, Lyngba versicolor(blue green), and other water cooling tower algae.

Algitrol is compatible with most commonly used cooling tower chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or premixed with other water-treating chemicals.

Algitrol works best when added by itself directly to tower water.

Algitrol t is highly concentrated and should be flushed from skin and eyes with water if splashed on them. Algitrol is not a foodstuff and should not come in contact with food.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE


Initial dose: One gallon Algitrol to 5,000 gallons of water.
Maintenance dose: One quart Algitrol to 5,000 gallons of water.

Initial dose is used when the tower is beginning treatment. If tower has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after the algae debris is removed from the tower. Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days. If high temperatures prevail or tower has heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently. If makeup water is added at a rate of more than 10% per week of tower capacity, add one quart of Algitrol for each 10,000 gallons of fresh makeup water added per week. Algitrol should be added to the sump of the water cooling tower. This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge treated effluent into lakes, streams, or ponds.

## DANGER-KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN
