

DIRECTIONS: SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

INDOORS: To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, and Flying Moths. Close all doors and windows. Cover or remove all exposed food and utensils. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Direct spray upward into center of the room with a slow, sweeping motion. Keep nozzle 3 reet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room before re-entry. Repeat as needed.

To Kill Roaches and Waterbugs: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes, behind rabinets, etc., where roaches hide. Hit as many insects as nossible directly with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Ants. Spray ant hills liberally. Spray ant trails over window and goor sills and other locations. Repeat as needed.

For house plants, spray in snort bursts, holding the can 18 inches from foliage when spraying English Ivy and African Violets. Spray both sides of the leaves lightly. Do not wet. Repeat as often as necessary, Kills Aphids (plant lice), Spider Mites, Exposed Thrips, Lace Rugs.

OUTDOORS: For histed insects or Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Dathias, Delphiniums, Galdioli, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses, and Snapdragons, Also, for insects specified below on Evergreens and Small Ornamental Deciduous Trees, Chrubs and Mines.

When sprayed directly on in ects this spray kills the following socking insects: Aphids, Leafhoppers, Spotted Mites, Thrips (exposed) and Lace Bugs. Kills the following chewing insects. Southern Army Worm, Mexican Bean Beeties, Climbing Cutworms and Japanese Beetles when sprayed directly.

For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow sweeping motion. Keep can 18 inches from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. I pray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not ipray when temperatures exceed 90 F.

This product may be used outside on porches, patios, and in the yard and pichic area to kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Ghats, and Other Small Flying Insects, flog he area liberally. Spray with the breeze, allowing the fog to drift into shrubbery and other places where insects harbour. Repeat as necessary
