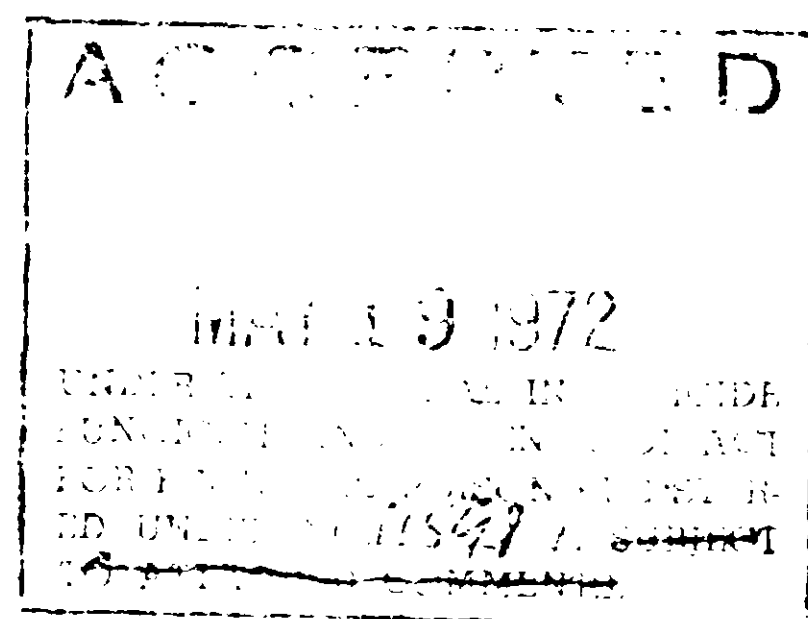


WATER-BASE HOUSE AND GARDEN PRESSURIZED SPRAY

**DIRECTIONS: SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT.
APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.**

INDOORS: To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, and Flying Moths.
Close all doors and windows. Cover or remove all exposed food and
utensils. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Direct spray upward
into center of the room with a slow, sweeping motion. Keep nozzle
3 feet from surfaces. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spray-
ing. Ventilate room before re-entry. Repeat as needed.

To Kill Roaches and Waterbugs: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices,
moist areas, and openings around sinks and pipes, behind cabinets,
etc., where roaches hide. Hit as many insects as possible directly
with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Ants: Spray ant hills liberally. Spray ant trails over window
and door sills and other locations. Repeat as needed.

For house plants, spray in short bursts, holding the can 18 inches
from foliage when spraying English Ivy and African Violets. Spray
both sides of the leaves lightly. Do not wet. Repeat as often as
necessary. Kills Aphids (plant lice), Spider Mites, Exposed Thrips,
Lace Bugs.

OUTDOORS: For listed insects on Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chry-
santhemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Galdioli, Irises, Marigolds, Pe-
tunias, Roses, and Snapdragons. Also, for insects specified below on
Evergreens and Small Ornamental Deciduous Trees, Shrubs and
Vines.

When sprayed directly on insects this spray kills the following
sucking insects: Aphids, Leafhoppers, Spotted Mites, Thrips (ex-
posed) and Lace Bugs. Kills the following chewing insects: Southern
Army Worm, Mexican Bean Beetles, Climbing Cutworms and Japa-
nese Beetles when sprayed directly.

For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still.
Use slow sweeping motion. Keep can 18 inches from plants. Avoid
wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per
second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when
needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do
not spray when temperatures exceed 90° F.

This product may be used outside on porches, patios, and in the
yard and picnic area to kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, and Other
Small Flying Insects. Fog the area liberally. Spray with the breeze,
allowing the fog to drift into shrubbery and other places where
insects harbour. Repeat as necessary.

Contents under pressure. Store upright in a cool place (not over
120° F). Do not place on hot surface. Do not puncture the can.
Never throw in fire or incinerator. May stain finished surfaces if
sprayed too closely.
