

### DIRECTIONS

To Operate - Remove Protective Cover

1. Shake can before using.
2. Hold can 10" to 12" from plant.
3. Be sure spray nozzle points outward.
4. Press down on actuator, spray lightly in short one-second bursts.
5. Spray plant from all sides including under, as well as upper leaf surfaces.

This spray is particularly effective on African Violets, Philodendron, Azaleas, Boston Ferns, Fuchsias, Ivy and Rubber Plants. Spray formulated for the control of aphids, spider mites and exposed thrips. For mealy bugs, use special care to wet insects thoroughly. For white fly, repeat application frequently. On other insects repeat application as needed.
