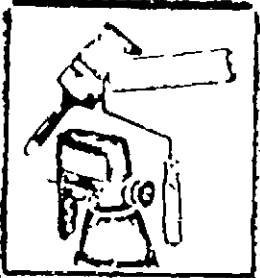
**PREPARATION**

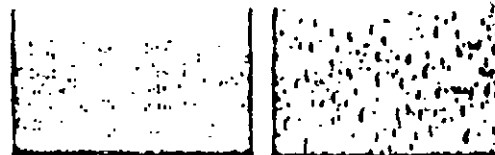

Finnaren and Haley STAIN & WOOD PRESERVATIVE is an oil base semi-transparent stain that has been especially formulated to be fade-resistant and to repel water. This stain deeply penetrates the wood and brings out its natural beauty, while protecting against wood rot, mildew and decay. Finnaren & Haley STAIN & WOOD PRESERVATIVE is for exterior use only and is recommended for Shingles (not asbestos), Shakes, Clapboards, Plywood Siding, Decks, Porches, Railings, Outdoor Furniture, Structural Support Timbers, Flat Beds, Cold Frames and Greenhouses. This product is not recommended for wood used for ground, food, feed or potable water contact. Cover desirable plants and shrubs to avoid possible injury. Do not use over painted or varnished surfaces. When using over previously stained areas, use the same color or a darker color. If repainting is eventually desired, surface must be well weathered at least 9 months.

**SURFACE PREPARATION:** When staining newly constructed or aged non-coated wood surfaces, consult your F & H sales representative for specific surface preparation. All surfaces must be clean and dry before staining. **MILDEW** - if mildew is present, remove completely from the surface with mildew remover before staining. Follow directions on package. This stain has been formulated to be mildew resistant, but no stain can wholly prevent the growth of mildew under conditions ideal for its growth. Therefore, we assume no responsibility for mildew development.

- **DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Stir thoroughly before using and frequently while using. Do not thin F&H STAIN & WOOD PRESERVATIVE Stain may be applied with natural bristle brush, tulle or sprayed. Stain only a few boards or a small area at a time. Vertical boards or shingles should be stained continuously from the top, always working to the edge of a board or shingle to avoid overlapping. Horizontal siding should be started at the top and worked across, always working towards an edge or break such as a door or window. Avoid overlapping. Keep a wet edge. Since stain color vary on different types of wood, test the stain first on the wood in an inconspicuous area. Certain woods such as redwood and cedar contain natural dyes (tannin) which sometimes bleed through the stain surface. In time, after exposure to the elements, the tannin stain should disappear. **IMPORTANT** Where one container is not enough to cover a large footage necessary, all containers should be thoroughly intermixed to ensure uniformity of color.

**NOTE TO USER:** Apply only when temperature of surface, air and stain temperatures are over 50°F. (10°C). Do not mix with oil, water, or other types of paint or stain. Clean brushes and equipment with mineral spirits. Do not use oil base stains on hardboard or compressed fiber siding. If possible, avoid direct sunlight when applying.

**DRYING TIME—Recoat—24 hours.**

# STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Do not expose this product to excessive heat. **DISPOSAL:** *Household Users:* Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. *Commercial Users:* Pesticide/Product Disposal—Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. ## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
