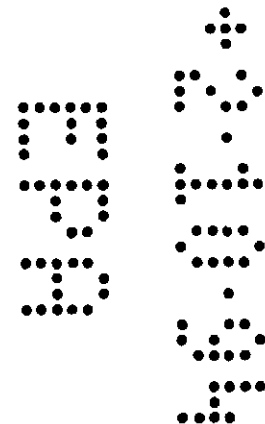

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
