#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- The application rate for wettable powder formulations on strawberries must not exceed 2 lbs. Active ingredient per acre.
- All wettable powder formulations must contain directions for use for water-soluble packaging for such wettable powder formulations, and must not contain directions for use for any other type of packaging. (The terms and conditions of registration must also be amended after EPA approval to reflect that wettable powder formulations may only be packaged in water-soluble packaging).
- All liquid formulations allowing use of the product on dry beans must contain directions for use for closed mixing systems, and must contain label language requiring that the product may not be used on dry beans unless mixed in a closed mixing system.
- The application rate for liquid formulations on citrus must be reduced to no more than 3 pounds active ingredient per acre.
