STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger, or, if available, by administering syrup of ipecac. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: There is no specific antidote for atrazine. If this product is ingested, induce emesis or lavage stomach. The use of an aqueous slurry of activated charcoal may be considered.

This pesticide is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste Representative at the nearest regional office of the Environmental Protection Agency. 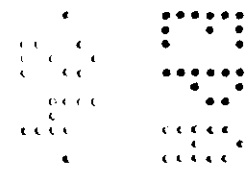
DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Formulators using this product are responsible for obtaining EPA registration for their formulated product.

Only for formulation into a herbicide for (1) the following uses; corn, sorghum and sorghum-sudan hybrids, fallow ground, roadsides, turfgrass for fairways, lawns, sod production, and similar areas, conifers, CRP acres, sugarcane, macadamia nuts, guava, conifers; (2) uses for which the USEPA has accepted the required data and/or citations of data that the formulator has submitted in support of registration; and (3) uses for experimental purposes that are in compliance with USEPA requirements.

This product can only be used to formulate products with agricultural weed control directions if the labeling for such end use products contains a restricted use classification and the following information and/or revised use directions. This product may not be used to formulate end use products for nonselective weed control on noncrop land.

THIS PRODUCT IS A RESTRICTED USE HERBICIDE DUE TO GROUND AND SURFACE WATER CONCERNS. USERS MUST READ AND FOLLOW ALL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE IN ORDER TO MINIMIZE POTENTIAL FOR ATRAZINE TO REACH GROUND AND SURFACE WATER.

2. Users are required to wear long sleeve shirts and long pants or equivalent, chemical resistant gloves, and waterproof boots. In addition, persons involved in mixing/loading operations are required to use heavy-duty chemical resistant gloves or neoprene gloves and a face shield or goggles.
3. Ground water contamination may be reduced by diking and flooring of permanent liquid bulk storage sites with an impermeable material.
4. This product may not be mixed/loaded or used within 50 feet of all wells, including abandoned wells, drainage wells, and sink holes. This product may not be mixed or loaded within 50 feet of intermittent streams and rivers, natural or impounded lakes and reservoirs. This product may not be applied aerially or by ground within 66 feet of the points where field surface water runoff enters perennial or intermittent streams and rivers or within 200 feet around natural or impounded lakes and reservoirs. If this product is applied to highly erodible land, the 66 foot buffer or setback from runoff entry points must be planted to crop, seeded with grass, or other suitable crop.
5. Postemergence application to corn and sorghum must be made before corn and sorghum reach 12 inches in height.
6. Applications for quackgrass suppression in corn and sorghum are restricted to a spring application only. No fall applications are permitted.
7. A.) For soil applications prior to crop emergence (i.e., early preplant, preplant incorporated, preplant surface, at planting, or preemergence). i.) On highly erodible soils (as defined by Soil Conservation Service (SCS), if conservation tillage is utilized (≥ 30 plant residue), the maximum rate is 2 lbs. ai/acre. If plant residue is < 30 , the maximum rate is 1.6 lbs. ai/acre. ii.) On soils not highly erodible, the maximum rate is 2 lbs. ai/acre. B.) For postemergence applications, if there has been no previous soil application for that crop, the maximum rate is 2 lbs. ai/acre. If there has been a previous soil application to that crop, do not exceed a total of 2.5 lbs. ai/acre/calendar year.
8. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.
9. Where there are state and local requirements regarding atrazine use (including lower maximum rates and/or setbacks) which are different from the label, the more restrictive/protective requirements must be followed.
