DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For use by commercial pesticide formulators only for formulation into an herbicide, mildewcide or algacide for the following uses: alfalfa, apple, artichoke, asparagus, banana and plantain, barley, berries crop group, birdsfoot trefoil, citrus, clover, corn, cotton, filberts, grape, grass seed crops, oats, olive, papaya, peach, peas, pear, peppermint, pineapple, potatoes, rye, sorghum, sugarcane, tree nut crop group, tree plantings, vetch, walnut, wheat, and non-crop weed control, ornamental ponds / aquaria, industrial adhesives and coatings, paints, emulsions and polymer compounds, wood protection treatment (outdoor) to buildings and other products (f. ex., architectural algicidal use, exterior siding).
