The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. The next label printing of this product must use this labeling unless subsequent changes have been approved. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Adama Diquat Concentrate is to be used only for formulating into herbicide products intended for the following uses:

1) Terrestrial Non-Food Uses in Noncrop or nonplanted areas around farms including: Fence lines, farmyards, farm buildings, fuel storage areas, barrier strips, equipment areas, and dry (non-flooded) portions of ponds, lakes and ditches; Landscape, industrial, recreational, commercial, residential and public areas (rights-of-way including railroads, highways, roads, dividers and medians, pipelines, public utility lines, pumping stations, transformer stations and substations, electrical utilities, commercial buildings, manufacturing plants, storage yards, rail yards, fence lines and parkways, edges and non-flooded portions of ponds, lakes and ditches); Commercial greenhouses and nurseries, ornamental seed crops (flowers, bulbs, etc.), Ornamental gardens, walkways, patios, beneath greenhouse benches, along driveways and or around golf courses; Turf

renovation (all turf areas except commercial sod farms), dormant established turf grass (non-food/feed uses only).

2) Aquatic, Non-Food Uses on - drainage ditches, lakes and ponds where there is little or no outflow of water; bayous, canals, drainage ditches, lakes, marshes, ponds, reservoirs, rivers, streams and other slow moving or quiescent bodies of water;

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning or equipment.

Pesticide Storage: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Store at temperatures above 32°F. Do not store or transport near feed or food. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.

Container Handling:

Nonrefillable Containers 5 gallons to Bulk: Nonrefillable Container: Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available. Clean container promptly after emptying. Triple rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank. Fill the container 1/4 full with water. Replace and tighten closures. Tip container on its side and roll it back and forth, ensuring at least one complete revolution, for 30 seconds. Stand the container on its end and tip it back and forth several times. Turn the container over onto its other end and tip it back and forth several times. Empty the rinsate into application equipment or a mix tank or store rinsate for later use of disposal. Repeat this procedure two more times.

Pressure rinse as follows: Empty the remaining contents into application equipment or a mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Hold container upside down over application equipment or mix tank and continue to drain for 10 seconds after the flow begins to drip. Fill the container about 10% full with water and spray all sides while adding water. Agitate vigorously or recirculate water with the pump for two minutes. Pour or pump rinsate into application equipment or rinsate collection system. Repeat this rinsing procedure two more times.
