# **SPARKLE**

### **TOILET BOWL CLEANER**

SPARKLE BOWL CLEANER is a strong chemical compound for removing accumulations and stains from toilet bowls and urinals.

#### **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Remove the water by forcing it over trap with swab
- 2. Holding bottle over bowl or urinal to prevent spilling on the floor, pour 1 ounce of SPARKLE BOWL CLEANER direct to soiled areas of the bowl allow contact time.
- 3. With swab clean entire surface of bowl or urinal, especially under rim and water outlets.
- 4. Flush bowl or urinal and rinse out swab.

### DANGER CORROSIVE

# **ANTIDOTE**

INTERNAL-Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesia, chalk, or small pieces of soap, softened with water, in milk or raw egg white.

In case of ingestion or injury, get medical attention.

Call a Physician immediately.

EXTERNAL, SKIN-Wipe off the acid gently, immediately flood the surface with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.

EYES- Wash with water for 15 minutes Get prompt medical attention.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
