DIRECTIONS

Remove protective cap. Hold dispenser upright with valve opening away from face. Push button completely down to release jet-stream. Aim at nests which may be in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks, or crevices in buildings, holes in the ground, under rocks, etc.

The jet-stream allows you to stand 12 feet or more away from the nest while spraying hornets, bees, wasps and yellow jackets. The sprayed nests should be rid of these pests within 24 hours after treatment.

RESIDUAL ACTION - The jet-stream spray will leave a residual coating of insecticide that will continue to kill weeks after application. If reinfestation occurs due to migration or removal of insecticide coating by rain, or cleaning solution, repeat the treatment.
