For use in institutions, Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Offices, Schools, Motels, Hotels, Homes, and Apartments. Use only as a crack and crevice treatment in edible product areas of Federally inspected meat and poultry plants.

Roaches, Waterbugs, Silverfish, Crickets, Carpet Beetles, Brown Dog Ticks, and Fleas: Spray infested cracks and hiding places thoroughly. Direct spray into moist places and around sinks, bath tubs, drains, laundry tubs, and pipes through walls and floors. Spray behind cabinets, stove, refrigerator, and counters. Will not stain woodwork. To control carpet beetles - spray the underside of carpets.

Ants: Thoroughly spray ant trails and areas around door frames and window sills. It is frequently desirable to treat the openings around water pipes, heat ducts, electrical outlets, and baseboards where ants may come into rooms from wall spaces and partitions.

Spiders and Scorpions: Spray wherever these insects may enter the home, such as around door frames and window sills. In garages, wood houses, cabins, and outhouses, spray until wet where these insects crawl.

Fleas, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, June Bugs, and Flying Moths: As an aid to reduce the annoyance from these insects in entering the home, spray the outside surfaces of screens, door and window frames, and other places such as open porch fixtures where these insects gather. **Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Spray infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do not spray animals.
