- Petroleum Distillate 13.75%

DIRECTIONS:

Remove protective cap. Hold dispenser upright with valve opening away from face. Push button completely down to release stream.

FOR CONTROL OF WASPS, HORNETS, AND BEES:

Apply to the nest in the early morning or late evening when these pests are at rest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, soaking the nest with the spray. Repeat as necessary. Avoid wetting vegetation with this spray, as it will be damaged. Do not use as a space spray. Spray infested areas such as under porches, eaves, doors, and window frames.

OTHER USES—OUTDOORS ONLY:

For control of ants, clover mites, crickets, earwigs, millipedes, sowbugs and brown dog ticks: Spray infested areas thoroughly, including outside surfaces of screen frames, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, and other places where insects may enter or harbour. For ants, spray hills and runways. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation. Do not use as a space spray.

CAUTION:

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Contact with skin, eyes, or clothing should also be avoided. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling. If poisoning occurs, get prompt medical aid. Avoid contamination of food, utensils, and food preparation areas.

To Physician: Atropine Sulfate is antidotal.

DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN—

FLAMMABLE. Contents under pressure. Contains petroleum distillates—Do not use near fire, heated surfaces, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not expose to temperatures above 130° F. Avoid contamination of fish ponds. Remove pets from area before spraying.
