

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetlee, Saw-Tooth Beetlee, and Rice Weevils: Find and destroy infested package Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of trinsects present. Place clean paper on shelves, and return packa shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

Te Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticke: Remove and destroy old pe Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and do wall cracks, and local area of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do animals. Put fresh bedding in pets quarters after spray has dried, dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product befor them to extend area. them to enter treated area.
