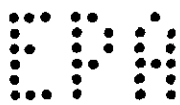
Dear Ms. Bordelon:

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ LABEL CAREFULLY. MAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN BUNDS.**

**To Kill House Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, and Gnats:** Open doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entering and destroy fallen insects.

**To Kill Cockroaches, Ants, and Crickets:** Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of areas suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be given to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, spray around window frames, ant trails, and other areas of entry. If necessary, repeat.

**To Kill Carpet Beetles:** Directly spray as many insects as possible on both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of seats and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, under furniture, and wherever these insects are seen or suspected of harboring.

**To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-Toothed Beetles, and Rice Weevils:** Find and destroy infested packages. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the insects present. Place clean paper on shelves, and return packages when shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Sewbugs, Centipedes, Firebrats, and Spiders:** Contact insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of areas suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be given to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, and behind stoves and refrigerators.

**To Kill Fleas and Brown Dog Ticks:** Remove and destroy old pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door wall cracks, and local area of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not use on animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. Dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before they enter treated area.

### Precautionary Statements Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals **CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact immediately flush skin with plenty of water. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage, or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets and birds and cover aquariums before spraying. In hospitals, remove all patients from treatment. Ventilate for 2 hours before returning patients.

### PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, potholes).

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**Storage:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.  
**Disposal:** Do not puncture or incinerate empty container. Empty container and put in trash collection.
