
The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

As new labels are prepared, delete the references to related compounds of d-trans allethrin and other isomers of d-(cis/trans) phenothrin in the ingredient statement. Include the percentage figure for d-trans allethrin related compounds as part of the total for inert ingredients. Include the percentage for other isomers of phenothrin as part of the declaration for that active so that its percentage reads 0.2%.

Delete --allyl homolog of cinerin I-- from the ingredient statement. It no longer accurately represents the allethrin in this formulation.

Refer to the Sumithrin Registration Standard for the correct chemical name for d-(cis/trans)phenothrin to be used in the ingredient statement.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy old pet bedding and replace. Use product as stated above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry. Repeat as necessary to bring infestation under control. To Operate Valve: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in center of room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash contaminated skin with soap and water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not use in food preparation areas, commercial food processing preparation areas, storage and serving areas. In apartments and living quarters, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS: Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. If inhaled: Remove patient to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If on skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected skin areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Disposal: Do not incinerate or puncture empty container. Replace cap.
