Remove from the Directions For Use heading the words "General Classification".

Although we still encourage inclusion, we have determined that it is acceptable to exclude from labels the phrase "If you go to a doctor, take this repellent with you". You do not need to submit an amendment to remove this from your label.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool dry area from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Do not puncture or incinerate container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

To repel the insects listed on the Front Panel, first remove protective cap. Hold can at least 12 inches away, point valve in desired direction and press button to spray. Use just enough repellent to cover exposed skin and/or clothing. Do not use under clothing. Avoid overexposure. Frequent reapplication and saturation is unnecessary for effectiveness. Do not apply to eyes and mouth and do not apply to the hands of young children. Do not spray directly on face. To apply to face, spray on hands and rub on. After returning indoors, wash treated skin with soap and water. Wash treated clothing. For ticks and chiggers, also apply liberally to shoe tops, socks and around openings in clothing. Avoid contact with plastics, such as eyeglass frames, and such fabric as acetate rayon.
