

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE General Classification

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

ENVI-CIDE II has been designed specifically for Hospitals, Nursing Homes, Institutions, Offices, Schools, Motels and Hotels as a disinfectant, deodorant and air refresher. It is recommended for disinfection of telephones, bed springs, door knobs, linen carts, hampers, wheel chairs, light switches, garbage pails and other clean inanimate hard non-porous surfaces.

**SURFACE DISINFECTION AND DEODORIZATION:** (1) First remove soil deposits from surface to be treated. (2) Hold can six inches from surface and spray until completely wet, allowing the surface to remain wet for 10 minutes.

**AIR DEODORIZER AND AIR REFRESHER:** Point spray upwards to center of room and spray for three seconds.

**MILDEWSTAT** — To control mold and mildew on hard non-porous surfaces (such as floors, walls, table tops), spray the surfaces to be treated. Making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat application at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS WARNING

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed.

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

When used as directed, ENVI-CIDE II is formulated to disinfect inanimate hard surfaces (such as walls, desk tops, sink tops, telephones, door knobs, diaper pails, toilet seats, bed pans, and hampers).

In addition, ENVI-CIDE II deodorizes those areas which generally are hard to keep fresh smelling (such as garbage storage areas, empty garbage bins and cans, rest rooms, shower stalls and other areas which are prone to odors caused by microorganisms).

When used as directed, ENVI-CIDE II demonstrates effective disinfection against: *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella choleraesuis*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa* and *Trichophyton mentagrophytes*.

The product is fungicidal against Pathogenic fungi (Athletes Foot Fungus) when used as directed on hard surfaces found in the bathroom, shower stall, and locker room, or other clean hard non-porous surfaces commonly contacted by the bare feet.


