

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
WARNING**

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Inhalation of fumes from this product may be harmful. Use only with adequate ventilation. Avoid contact. Keep away from children. Notice to physicians: Sympathomimetic Amines are contraindicated.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD

Do not apply directly to water.

PHYSICAL HAZARD

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flames. Concentrated vapors should be kept away from flames or hot ignition sources such as welding where concentrated vapors may generate toxic gases on contact with open flames, red hot surfaces or other heat producing conditions. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Insert extension tube into aerosol actuator. Insert extension tube into the top of the ant mound and depress actuator for 10 to 15 seconds. Repeat application at least 3 more times at locations around the mound (approximately 2 oz. of pesticide). Do not disturb the mound more than necessary when treating to avoid migration of the ants and to obtain a more effective kill.

Note: The kill rate of Ant Eater varies with the temperature. At temperatures below 50°F it may take from one to three weeks to kill all ants in the mound. Kill rate is also affected by excess moisture. Treatment should not be made when the mound is saturated with water. At normal temperatures (68-90°F) a total kill will result in approximately one to eight hours.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE. Store in a cool area away from heat and open flames. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage and disposal.

DISPOSAL. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed - call a physician or poison control center. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

If inhaled and dizziness occurs from exposure to vapors, remove patient to fresh air. Call a physician. If breathing stops, give artificial respiration.

If on skin - wash with soap and water.

If in eyes - flush with water and call a physician.
