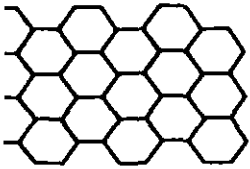

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Control of Wasps and Hornets: It is preferable to apply this product in the evening after all the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is soaked with the spray. Repeat as necessary.

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid inhalation of vapors. May cause eye irritation. **Avoid contact with skin and eyes.** Wash contaminated skin promptly with soap and warm water. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if necessary.
