The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Update the storage and disposal statement you now have on your label to comply with PR Notice 83-3.
 - b. Delete the statement "FLAMMABLE. Contents Under Pressure" from the child hazard warning signal word section of the labeling, and the term "Flammable" from the precautionary section of the label for EPA Registration No. 11623-29.
3. With respect to the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) for EPA Registration No. 11623-29, the limits on the CSF should be reversed in columns 14.a. and 14.b. Please correct.

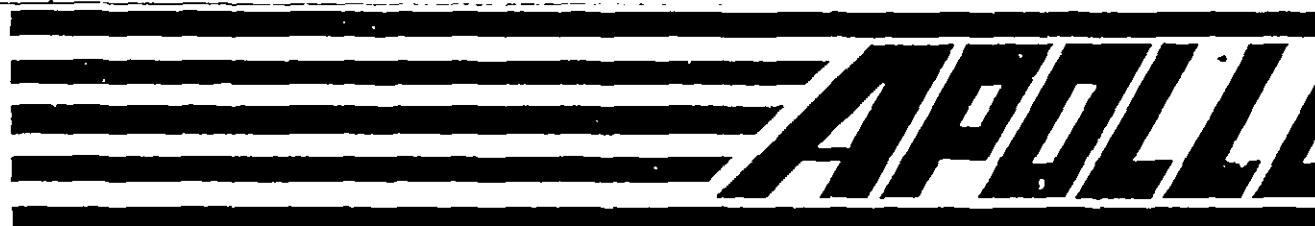

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General Use Residual Spray: Residual Spray is a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply the product only as a coarse spray or pack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces and wet Residual is needed. For a coarse spray push the button down. For crack and crevice spray push the button forward.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:
To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Solder, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, and Carpet Beetles. Spray areas where these pests are found or may occur, including left corners of rooms and beneath, cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames, behind and beneath areas, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.
To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas. Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as the beds and nesting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Do not spray where pets are present and replaced wet areas with bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:
To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Solder, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, and Carpet Beetles. Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a fine stream should be used in joints between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to walls and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Fleas and Mosquitoes: Use dry out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Do not spray outdoors of windows and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Do not spray dark corners and localized nesting areas, such as under eaves, porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Fleas and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surface will be killed. Repeat treatment if necessary.
