3. The flashpoint reported on the Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) exceeds the one expected for this product. Please check and resubmit. Mixtures marketed under pressure, including those containing hydrocarbons, are subject in their entirety to tests indicated in 40 CFR 162(h)(2)(iii). (Flashpoints are conveniently measured after collecting the liquid expelled from the container in an open cup chilled with dry ice.)

4. We also note that the upper and lower certified limits (column 14.a. and 14.b) for the Pyrethrins listed in your CSF are incorrect. The figures should be 0.05 and 0.055, respectively.

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

**General:** Use this residual spray as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, waterbugs, silverfish, ticks, fleas and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coarse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Repeat as needed.

**FOR SPOT TREATMENT:**

**To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs, Earwigs and Carpet Beetles:** Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets, cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames, behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets, and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet bedding and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of food and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Do Not Spray Pets With This Product. Pets should be treated with a registered product for flea and tick control in conjunction with this treatment.

**FOR CRACKS AND CREVICE:**

**To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Earwigs, and Carpet Beetles:** Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, where the above-listed insects hide.

Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

**Flies and Mosquitoes:** Only out of doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of windows and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized nesting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.
