Dear Ms. Burnell:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

1. Revise front of the label-- replace " Inert Ingredients" with the phrase "Other Ingredients".
2. Revise the First Aid statement as followed:
 - a. In the If Swallowed statement, replace "Do not give any liquid to the person" with "Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow."
 - b. Add "Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice" to the If inhaled and If on skin or clothing statements.

This product will kill cockroaches, confused flour beetles, crickets, fleas, houseflies, pill bugs, rice weevils, saw-toothed grain beetles, small flying moths, and ticks.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets, or under counters or tables. DO NOT use in a room 5 feet by 5 feet or smaller; instead, allow fogger to enter from other rooms. **Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames, or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.).** Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. **TO OPERATE VALVE:** To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under the fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding or replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid inhalation of vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, food

serving or storage areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover or remove exposed food. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

FIRST AID

Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on skin or clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. **If inhaled:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. **If in eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed. Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!

If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
