DIRECTIONS

FOR CONTROL OF WASP AND HORNETS: It is preferable to apply this product in the evening after all the insects have returned to the nest. Air should be opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is soaked with the spray. Repeat as necessary.
