#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

##### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets, or under counters or tables. DO NOT use in a room 5 feet by 5 feet or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames, or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry. TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under the fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding or replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.
