Dear Mr. Sabo:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Two (2) copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment. A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) As we requested in our letter of May 27, 1999, please remove the general term "ticks" from your label. The efficacy data you cited does not support this general term. You must state specifically "Brown Dog Tick". Thus on your front panel which begins "Kills flies, cockroaches...etc. you must delete the term "Ticks". Additionally, under your Directions for Use, please change "To kill ticks and fleas" to read "To kill Brown Dog Ticks and fleas".
- 2) In your section entitled "To Operate Valve", change your last sentence to read "Repeat spraying if necessary, but no sooner than within 2 weeks".
- 3) Please change your "IF SWALLOWED" statement to read the following:

IF SWALLOWED:

- Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.
- Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.
- Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT.

Cover exposed foods, dishes, and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets, or under counters or tables. DO NOT use in a room 5 feet by 5 feet or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames, or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under the fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding or replace. Use product as above. Treat dogs and cats with registered tick control product prior to re-entry.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid inhalation of vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention. If on skin or clothing: Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Disposal: Do not incinerate or puncture empty container. Replace cap and discard container in trash.
