Dear Ms. Burnell:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the following label revision provision(s):

General Comment:

Delete all text throughout the label marked with "strikethrough."

Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals subsection comment(s):

- 2. Revise the 1st sentence to read: "Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin."
- 3. Revise the 3rd sentence to read: "Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco."

Directions for Use section comment(s):

4. To facilitate inclusion of language from the REDs for tetramethrin and MGK 264 insecticide synergist, add the following new subsection in its own text box immediately following the statement "It is a violation of Federal law ...":

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS & USE RESTRICTIONS

- Apply this product only as specified on this label.
- For indoor residential use only.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only
 protected handlers may be in the treated area during application. Do not remain in treated area. Exit area
 immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors and/or mists have dispersed.
- Do not apply when food is present. Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or when facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Prior to application, exposed food should be covered or removed. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned with a suitable detergent and rinsed with potable water before use. Do not apply more than 1 time per day.
- Do not enter or allow others to enter treated area until sprays have dried.
- Wait at least two (2) hours after application then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) more hours. If an odor is still detected, additional ventilation is required.
- Do not apply directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to storm sewers, water bodies or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow this product to enter any drain during or after application.
- Remove pets and birds and cover fish aquariums and turn off air pump motor before application.

Directions for Use section comment(s), continued:

5. Within the paragraph starting with "**TO OPERATE VALVE**:," revise the 5th and 6th sentences to read "Leave the building at once and wait at least two (2) hours after application then open windows, vents and doors for two (2) more hours. If an odor is still detected, additional ventilation is required."

Storage and Disposal section comment(s): To facilitate inclusion of language from PR Notice 2007-4:

- 6. Replace the existing "Pesticide Storage:" subsection with "Pesticide Storage: Keep this product dry in a tightly closed container, when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame."
- 7. Replace the "Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling:" subsection with "Container Disposal: Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions."

- 8. Revise the 1st optional marketing statement to read "Kills Ants, Cockroaches, Fleas, Spiders, Mosquitoes, Houseflies & Other Listed Insects"
- 9. Revise the 2nd optional marketing statement to read "**FOR INDOOR USE IN THE FOLLOWING AREAS ONLY:** Apartments, Homes (Attics, Basements, Garages and Household Storage Areas), Campers, Boats, Pet Sleeping Quarters and Cabins."

First Aid Statement section comment(s):

- 10. On the row entitled "IF SWALLOWED:," revise the 1st bullet to read "Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice."
- 11. Revise the 3rd row to read "**HOT LINE NUMBER:** Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center, doctor, veterinarian or going for treatment. For additional information on this product (including health concerns, medical emergencies or pesticide incidents), you may call 1-800-xxx-xxxx." ¹

Please submit two (2) copies of the final printed labeling, incorporating the above changes, before releasing the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with section 6(e) of FIFRA. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

Induct will kill ants, cockroaches, confictivets, fleas, house saw-toothed hugs,

beetles, small flying moths, sow bugs, spiders (including black widow), and brown dog ticks.

DO NOT use more than one fogger per room. DO NOT use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets. cabinets or under counters or tables. Do not use in a room 5 ft, X 5 ft, or smaller; instead, allow fog to enter from other rooms. Turn off ALL ignition sources such as pilot lights (shut off gas valves), other open flames or running electrical appliances that cycle off and on (i.e., refrigerators, thermostats, etc.). Call your gas utility or management company if you need assistance with your pilot lights.

KEEP CONTAINER UPRIGHT

Cover exposed food dishes and food equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face when releasing. Use one unit for each 6.000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: Place several layers of newspaper or pad on stand or on table in the center of the room. Point valve opening away from face. To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for two hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying if necessary, but no sponer than within 2 weeks.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Destroy pet's old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment is completed. Use product as above. Pets should be treated with a registered flea and tick control product prior to reentering treated premises.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.

Pesticide Storage

Store in a cool, dry area. Always store pesticides in the original container. Store away from food or pet food.
