Dear Ms. Burnell:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Under the "Precautionary Statements" section, please move the statements "Do not use in food handling...until spray has dried" to the "Directions for Use" section of your label.
- 2. Under the "Directions for Use" section, either delete the phrases "Repeat as needed" or "Repeat treatment as necessary" or indicate a time period based on the residual efficacy of your product.
- 3. Revise the statement "Spray surfaces until wet" to read "Spray surfaces until wet but not to the point of runoff."
- 4. Under the "Physical or Chemical Hazards" section, add the word "heat" to the statement "Keep away from sparks and open flame" so that it reads "Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame."
- 5. Revise the first statement under the "Precautionary Statements" section to read "Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin.
- 6. Add the following statements to the end of the paragraph beginning "Do not use in food areas...": Under the "Directions for Use" section of your label, please add the following

statements as the second paragraph: In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Non food/feed areas where this product can be applied are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling)."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

General: Use this apply as a spot or crack and crevice treatment to control cockroaches, fleas, silverfish, ticks, waterbugs, and other insects listed below. Apply this product only as a coerse spray or crack and crevice treatment to localized areas where pests are found or may occur. Spray surfaces until wet. Rapest as needed.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT:

- To Kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Cricitets, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders: Spray areas where these insects are found or may hide including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls, along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Pests driven out of hiding places should be sprayed directly. For ants, spray and trails and around doors and windows, and whereverelse these pests may find entrance.
- a To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door trames, and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Pets old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. DO NOT SPRAY PETS WITH THIS PRODUCT.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT:

To Kill Ants, Black Widow Spiders, Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, and Spiders: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where these insects hide.

Files and Mosquitoes: Use only outdoors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and door frames as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios, and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

FIRST AID

Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. IF ON SIGN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rines skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artifical respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth, if possible. IF IN EYES: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains Petroleum Distillates – vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if inhaled, absorbed through skin. Causes eye irritation Avoid breathing vapor or spray, contact with skin, eyes or cothing. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served such as dining rooms but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Do not apply this product in patient rooms or in any rooms while occupied by the elderty or infirm. Do not apply to classrooms while in use. Do not apply in institutions (including libraries, sports facilities, etc.) in the immediate area where occupants are present.

Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Keep away from sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
