- c. Delete the phrase "DO-IT-ALL" in the product name. Words or phrases implying that a product possesses unique characteristics because of its composition are not acceptable. Likewise, claims which imply total control or elimination of pests are not acceptable.
  - d. The directions for use must state the sites of application to be treated. The preferred location is the front panel. An example of such a statement would be: " For Residential Use both indoors and outdoors. For commercial use in nonfood areas of industrial buildings, office buildings, theaters, hotels, motels."
  - e. Add the following limitations under the garden insect control paragraph: "Not for use on plants being grown for sale or other commercial use, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modifications or being grown in ornamental gardens or parks or lawns and grounds."
  - f. Please delete the sentence "If lice infestation should occur on humans, use an EPA registered product label for use on humans." from the first paragraph under "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS". EPA no longer regulates products for lice control on humans.
3. Please submit two (2) copies of your final printed label for before your release the product for shipment. Please refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). ### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals CAUTION

Avoid spraying in eyes. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands thoroughly after use. Vacate room after treatment and ventilate before reoccupying. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Cover or remove fishbowls. This product is not for use on humans. If lice infestation should occur on humans, use an EPA registered product labeled for use on humans.

**ANIMALS:** Do not spray directly in/on eyes, mouth or genitalia of pets. Use only on dogs. Do not use on cats or kittens. Do not use on puppies less than twelve (12) weeks old. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, aged, pregnant, medicated or nursing animals. Sensitivities may occur after using any pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur, bathe your pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

### Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply to any body of water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

### Physical Or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not use this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not use in the edible product areas of food/feed processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food/feed is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed or facility is in operation.

In the home, cover all food handling surfaces and cover or remove all food and cooking utensils, or wash thoroughly after treatment.

### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

HOUSEFLIES, FRUIT FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, BEES, BLACK FLIES, SKIPPER FLIES, BLOW FLIES, AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Repeat treatment as necessary.

COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS, AND PILLBUGS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray when ever possible. Repeat treatment as necessary.

**ANTS:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible. Repeat as necessary.

**FLEAS AND TICKS: (ADULTS AND LARVAE):** Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. A test application should be made to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

**TO CONTROL FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS:** Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Repeat application every two weeks if necessary.

**TO KILL LICE AND LOUSE EGGS:** Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for three seconds. Spray only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

**FOR THE CONTROL OF GARDEN INSECTS:** For use on roses, dahlias, asters and other ornamentals to kill Japanese Beetles hit by spray, as well as *Whiteflies, Aphids, exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites and Leafminers*. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area. Do not transport or store below 32°F.

**Disposal:** Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose of in trash. Can may be disposed of with other recyclables where local law permits. Do not incinerate or puncture.
