Use Restrictions & Precautions

- After space spray application, do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter until vapors, mists and aerosols have dispersed, and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.
- For space spray, except when applying to pests, do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children or pests either directly or through drift.
- Except when applying to dogs, do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

HOUSEFLIES, FRUIT FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, BEES, BLACK FLIES, SKIPPER FLIES, BLOW FLIES AND SMALL FLYING MOTHS: Close all doors and windows and spray room at the rate of 2 to 3 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion.

COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS, MILLIPEDES, CENTIPEDES, SOWBUGS AND PILLBUGS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray when ever possible.

ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible.

FLEAS AND TICKS (ADULTS AND LARVAE): Remove and thoroughly clean or discard pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, entire floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, and window and door frames. Infested upholstered furniture may also be treated with this product. Make a test application to upholstery or drapery fabrics in an inconspicuous place before use.

TO CONTROL FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS: Starting at the tail, stroke against the lay of the hair, spraying the parted fur in short bursts, directly behind the hand to insure penetrating the coat. Dampen the fur up to the head. Repeat application every two weeks if necessary.

TO KILL LICE AND LOUSE EGGS: Spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect again after drying, then proceed to spray entire area to be treated. Hold container upright with nozzle away from you. Depress valve and spray from a distance of 8 to 10 inches. Spray each square foot for three seconds. Spray only those garments and parts of bedding, including mattresses and furniture that cannot be either laundered or dry cleaned. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use.

FOR THE CONTROL OF GARDEN INSECTS: For use on roses, dahlas, asters and other ornamentals to kill *Japanese Beetles* hit by spray, as well as *Whiteflies, Aphids, Exposed Thrips, Spiders, Red Mites* and *Leafminers.* When spraying plants, do not hold can closer than 18 inches. Use sweeping motion. Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not spray plants when temperatures exceed 90°F. Contact insects directly whenever possible.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide Storage: Store in a cool, dry place. **Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling:** Do Not Puncture or Incinerate! *If empty:* Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. *If partly filled:* Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
