DIRECTIONS

FOR CONTROL OF WASPS, YELLOW JACKETS, AND HORNETS: It is preferable to apply this product in the evening after all the insects have returned to the nest. Aim valve opening at the nest and depress button, continuing to spray until the nest is saturated. Treated insects will fall out of the nest and die. Wait 48 hours before removing the nest. Repeat as necessary. Foliage of desirable plants contacted during spraying should be hosed off with water.

FOR CONTROL OF ANTS AND SPIDERS: (Outdoor only.) For control of ants and spiders found in areas such as along house foundation, foundation vents sills and ledges. Spray in short bursts to control pests.
