II insecticide is intended for use in and around residential structures and their immediate surroundings such as: apartments, atriums, attics, automobiles, basements, bathrooms, boats, cabins, campers, carports, cat sleeping quarters, clothes storage, condominiums, decks, dens, driveways, garages, gazebos, homes, kitchens, lanais, living rooms, parlors, patios, pet sleeping areas, play rooms, porches, recreational vehicles, rooms, solariums, storage areas, sun rooms, utility rooms and verandahs.

Causes moderate eye irritation. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water.

Physical or Chemical Hazards

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not apply this product in or on electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

APOLLO SPECTRUM CONTROL works in two ways: 1) it kills bugs fast on contact, and 2) its residual action keeps on killing for up to 4 weeks after you spray.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE. Hold container upright. Do not spray up into air. Apply to surfaces only. Remove protective cap and direct spray away from face. Hold can 12-15 inches from surface being sprayed. Press button down and spray as directed. Spray surface until slightly wet.

APOLLO SPECTRUM CONTROL will not stain surfaces or fabrics where water alone causes no damage.

INDOORS:

Ants, Centipedes, Crickets, Dermatitis, Firebrats, Fleas, Palmetto Bugs, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Ticks and Waterbugs: Apply thoroughly to all areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevices, and hidden areas around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers, bookcases, and similar areas. When pests are driven out, spray directly. Repeat as necessary.

Ants: Spray freely around ant trails, doors and windows and other places where ants enter the house. Repeat as necessary.

Ticks and Fleas on Surfaces: Remove pet bedding and destroy or clean thoroughly. Spray pet resting quarters. Adult fleas and larvae contacted by spray will be killed. Put fresh bedding down once spray has dried. Do not spray animals directly. Spray rugs and carpets where infestations are bad. Delicate fabrics should be tested for staining in an inconspicuous area prior to use.

Spiders: Apply along and behind baseboards, to window and door frames, corners, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas over which these pests may crawl.

Centipedes, Ground Beetles, Pillbugs, Sowbugs, Scorpions and Ticks: Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may enter premises. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations where these pests are found.

PANTRY PESTS – Grain Beetles (Rusty, Merchant and Saw-toothed), Flour Beetles (Red and Confused), Chocolate Moths, Cigarette Beetles, Clover Mites, Cluster Flies, Drugstore Beetles, Elmleaf Beetles, Rice Weevils, Lesser Grain Borers, Spider Beetles and Tobacco Moths: Treat exposed stages. Remove all food-stuffs, utensils and shelf paper from area to be treated. Discard used shelf paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray to shelves and in cracks and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets. Allow spray to dry prior to replacement of shelf paper, food and utensils.

Carpet Beetles (Black, Furniture and Varied): Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found.

OUTDOORS:

Point nozzle away from face. Hold can on a slight downward angle, approximately 12 - 15 inches from surface to be sprayed. For best results, spray when air is calm. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: For control of building infestations to Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Repeat treatment as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches (including Asian Cockroaches), Centipedes, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Waterbugs and Silverfish. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

Ants: Spray freely around ant trails and hills. Spray around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray freely on and around debris. Repeat as necessary.

Lone Star Ticks, Dog Ticks, Crickets, Fleas and Earwigs: Apply thoroughly to infestation in bushes, grass or weeds.

Wasps, Mud Daubers, Hornets and Bees: Spray nests and bees directly.

FLYING INSECTS. Houseflies, Gnats, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths: Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of windows and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Insects coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Do not store near heat or open flame. Store in a cool, dry area away from children.
Container Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture. Can may be disposed of with other recyclables where local law permits.
