FIRST AID

APOLLO CIK SPRAY II works in two ways: 1) it kills bugs fast on contact; and 2) its residual action keeps on killing for up to 4 weeks after you spray.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE Hold container upright. Do not spray up into air. Apply to surfaces only. Remove protective cap and direct spray away from face. Hold can 12-15 inches from surface being sprayed. Press button down and spray as directed. Spray surface until slightly wet.

APOLLO CIK SPRAY II will not stain surfaces or fabrics where water alone causes no damage.

*Apollo CIK Spray II insecticide is intended for use in and around residential structures and their immediate surroundings such as: apartments, attics, automobiles, basements, bathrooms, boats, cabins, campers, carports, cat sleeping quarters, clothes storage, condominiums, decks, dens, driveways, garages, gazebos, homes, kitchens, lawns, living rooms, parlors, patios, pet sleeping areas, play rooms, porches, recreational vehicles, rooms, solariums, storage areas, sun rooms, utility rooms and verandas.

INDOORS:
Ants, Centipedes, Crickets, Dermestids, Firebrats, Fleas, Palmate Bees, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Ticks and Waterbugs: Apply thoroughly to all areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevices, and hidden areas around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers, bookcases, and similar areas. When pests are driven out, spray directly. Repeat as necessary.
Ants: Spray around ant trails, doors and windows and other places where ants enter the house. Repeat as necessary.

Ticks and Fleas on Surfaces: Remove pet bedding and destroy or clean thoroughly. Spray pet resting quarters. Adult fleas and larvae contacted by spray will be killed. Put fresh bedding down once spray has dried. Do not spray animals directly. Spray rugs and carpets where infestations are bad. Delicate fabrics should be tested for staining in an inconspicuous area prior to use.

Spiders: Apply along and behind baseboards to window and door frames, corners, pipes, etc. age localities, attics, crawl spaces and other areas over which these pests may crawl.

Centipedes, Ground Beetles, Pillbugs, Sowbugs, Scorpions and Ticks: Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may enter premises. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations where these pests are found.

PANTRY PESTS - Grain Beetles (Rusty, Merchant and Saw-toothed), Flour Beetles (Red and Confused), Chocolate Moths, Casemate Beetle, Clover Mites, Cluster Flies, Druggstore Beetles, Elmwood Beetles, Rice Weevils, Lesser Grain Borers, Spider Beetles and Tobacco Moths: Treat exposed stages. Remove all food-stuffs, utensils and shelf paper from area to be treated. Discard used shelf paper and any infested foodstuffs. Apply spray to shelves and in cracks and crevices behind and under cupboards and cabinets. Allow spray to dry prior to replacement of shelf paper, food and utensils.

Carpet Beetles (Black, Furniture and Varied): Spray on and under edges of floor coverings, under rugs and furniture and in closets or other localities where these insects are found.

OUTDOORS:
Point nozzle away from face. Hold can on a slight downward angle, approximately 12 - 15 inches from surface to be sprayed. For best results, spray when air is calm. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing.

PESTS ON OUTSIDE SURFACES OF BUILDINGS: For control of building infestations to Ants, Clever Mites, Crickets and Sowbugs (Pillbugs). Spray foundation of building where insects are active and may find entrance up to a height of 2 to 3 feet. Apply as a residual spray to outside surfaces of buildings where insects tend to congregate. Repeat treatment as necessary.

CRAWLING INSECTS: Ants, Cockroaches (including Asian Cockroaches), Centipedes, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Waterbugs and Silverfish. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Also spray legs of tables and chairs to repel ants. Spray ant hills for best control.

Ants: Spray around ant trails and hills. Spray around nests hidden under steps, brickwork, concrete, etc. Break apart accessible nests and spray freely on and around debris. Repeat as necessary.

Lone Star Ticks, Dog Ticks, Crickets, Fleas and Earwigs: Apply thoroughly to infestation in bushes, grass or weeds.

Wasps, Mud Daubers, Hornets and Bees: Aim spray at nest opening. Applications should be made late in the evening when insects are at rest. Spray nests and bees directly.

FLYING INSECTS: Houseflies, Gnats, Mosquitoes and Small Flying Moths: Use only on outdoor surfaces. Spray outside surfaces of windows and door frames and other areas where these pests may enter the home. Insects coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place. Keep container closed. Do Not Puncture or Incinerate!
