STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition appear and get medical attention immediately.

IF ON SKIN: Wash thoroughly with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Active ingredient is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine, by injection only, is antidotal.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Keep out of any body of water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store in original container out of reach of children and pets. Do not store above 100 degrees F. for extended periods of time. If container is damaged or spill occurs, use product immediately or dispose of product and damaged container as indicated below.
