The Agency is in receipt of your revised label submitted December 26, 2008, and has confirmed the specified language with respect to the baling of hay has been added as requested. As previously noted, this change ensures negligible environmental exposure, and therefore, allows the Agency to proceed with a final registration review decision without data call in for the following:

850.4100 Seedling Emergence, Tier 1  
850.4150 Vegetative Vigor, Tier 1  
830.7050 Ultraviolet/Visible Absorption

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act as amended is acceptable.

One copy of the label stamped "Accepted" is enclosed for your records. This label supersedes all labels previously accepted for this product. Please submit one copy of the final printed label before the product is released for shipment.

The Agency has determined that the registrant may distribute and sell propionic acid products bearing old labels/labeling for 12 months from the date of issuance of this letter. Registrants and persons other than the registrant remain obligated to meet existing stocks requirements applicable to products they sell or distribute.

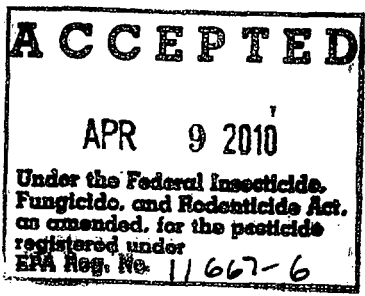

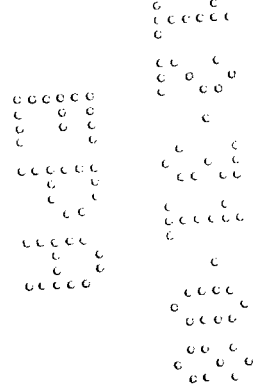

DANGER**

This product may not be formulated into end use products to be applied to pre-harvest hay and straw, cut hay and straw in the field prior to baling, or to hay and straw after it has been baled.

This product may be used to formulate products for specific use(s) not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding the support of such use(s).

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**PESTICIDE STORAGE:** Do not store or use this product near open flame. Keep container closed. Store in a cool, dry location away from incompatibles.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:** Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law.
