The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable provided that you make the following revisions before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Revise the heading "Pine Oil Disposal" to read "Pesticide Disposal".
2. Revise the Environmental Hazards to read as follows:

"This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or public waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA".
3. Revise the "Statement of Practical Treatment" to read as follows:

If in eyes: Call Physician. Hold eye lids open and flush with a gentle steady stream of water for 15 minutes.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention. CONCURRENCES
