The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

- Revise the Precautionary statements by including the signal word "Warning" immediately preceding the statement "Causes substantial, but temporary eye injury." 1.
- Revise the Storage and Disposal section by placing the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal." directly following the 2. heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL."

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3. Revise the If Swallowed section to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

4. Revise the If On Skin section to read:

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

- 5. Revise the Directions for Use by changing the statement "Mop or sponge with 1tbsp. Per gallons of water." to read "Mop or sponge with 1tbsp per 3 gallons of water."
- 6. Revise the First Aid Statements by including the statement "Have the product container or label with you when call a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment."
