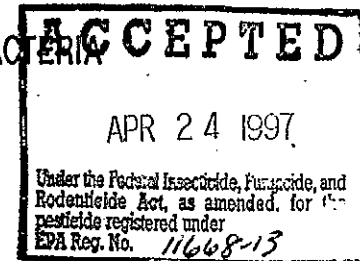

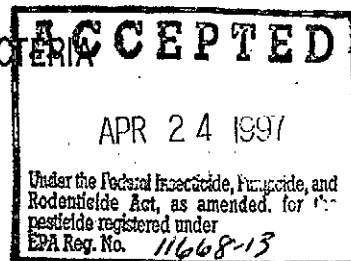

DIRECTIONS FOR USE
It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR STUBBORN STAINS: To remove bad stains (grease or grime) before laundering, soak stained spots in full strength EL PINOL 60 for a few minutes before laundering.

SOFTENS PAINT BRUSHES: Works on paint brushes, even those stiffened from oil based paints. Soak in full strength EL PINOL 60 a few hours or overnight. Turns stiff bristles soft.

Remove heavy soil or gross filth, thoroughly clean surface prior to application of product, use 2.5 ounces per gallon of water. Apply with mop or sponge and let stand for 10 minutes. Remove solution by mop or sponge.

BATHROOM:

For wash, basins, use 4 Tbsp. EL PINOL 60 per gallon of water, mop then rinse with clear water. For bathtub and shower stalls follow above directions. Add 2 Tbsp. EL PINOL 60 to toilet bowl at night, in the morning before flushing mop surface.

WOOD FLOORS:

Mop floors with a solution of 2 Tbsp. of EL PINOL 60 to 3 gallons of water. Use soap in solution if desired.

TILE AND CEMENT:

Mop floors with 4 Tbsp. of EL PINOL 60 to 3 gallons of water. Use soap if desired.

NOTE: Rubber or asphalt tile, rinse immediately with clear water.

Kitchen stoves, sinks, drainboards, refrigerators, for ordinary cleaning use 4 Tbsp. of EL PINOL 60 per gallon of water. For extra heavy grease use 1/2 EL PINOL 60 and 1/2 water. Let soak, rinse off. Treated food contact surface must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

GARBAGE PAILS: Use 2 Tbsp. EL PINOL 60 to 1 gallon of water.
