Dear Ms. Laird:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- Update First Aid Statement per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the Precautionary statements by including the signal word "Warning" immediately preceding the statement "Causes substantial, but temporary eye injury."
2. Revise the Environmental Hazards Statement to include the statement "This pesticide is toxic to fish."
3. Revise the Storage and Disposal section by placing the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal." directly following the heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL."

4. Revise the If Swallowed section to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

5. Revise the If On Skin section to read:

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

6. Revise the First Aid Statements by including the statement "Have the product container or label with you when call a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment."

7. The product makes claim as being a "Limited Disinfectant Against Odor Causing Bacteria." Odor causing bacteria is not a public health microorganism and no efficacy data is required. Since you can not disinfect odor causing bacteria and no standards (protocol) have been approved for testing against odor causing bacteria, you must revise the label claim to read "Effective Against Odor Causing Bacteria." Delete the words "disinfectant" and "disinfect" wherever it appears on the label.


8. Revise the Directions for Use by changing the statement "Remove solution by mop or sponge and let stand for 10 minutes. Remove solution by mop or sponge." to read "Remove solution by mop or sponge."

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three(3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with it's labeling.

FOR STUBBORN STAINS: To remove bad stains (grease or grime) before laundering, soak stained spots in full strength EL PINOL 60 for a few minutes before laundering.

SOFTENS PAINT BRUSHES: Works on paintbrushes, even those stiffened from oil based paints. Soak in full strength EL PINOL 60 a few hours or over night. Turns stiff bristles soft.

Remove heavy soil or gross filth; thoroughly clean surfaces prior to application of product use 2.5 ounces per gallon of water. Apply with mop or sponge and let stand for 10 minutes. Remove solution by mop or sponge and let stand for 10 minutes. Remove solution by mop or sponge.

KITCHENS: Stoves, sinks, drain boards, refrigerators, for ordinary cleaning use 4 Tbsp. of EL PINOL 60 per gallon of water. For extra heavy grease, use ½ EL PINOL 60 and ½ water. Let soak, rinse off. Treated food contact surfaces must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent and rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.
