LIMITED DISINFECTANT AGAINST ODOR-CAUSING BACTERIA FOR LAUNDRY:

(Cleaning and deodorizing): Add 1/4 cup EL PINOL T&R per load for top loading machines, or 1/2 cup for front loading machines along with soap or detergent. When soaking diapers, add 4 Tbsp. EL PINOL T&R per gallon of water.

FOR STUBBORN STAINS: To remove bad stains (grease spots) in full strength EL PINOL T&R for a few minutes.
SOFTENS PAINT BRUSHES: Works on paint brushes. Soak in full strength EL PINOL T&R a few hours or overnight.

FOR DISINFECTANT

Remove heavy soil or gross filth, thoroughly clean surfaces with 1 ounce per gallon of water. Apply with mop or sponge. Rinse with water solution by mop or sponge.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL

Do not re-use empty container. Wrap container and place in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR CLEANING AND

BATHROOM:

For wash basins, use 4 Tbsp. EL PINOL T&R per gallon of clear water. For bathtub and shower stalls—follow above directions. T&R to toilet bowl at night. In the morning before use.

WOOD FLOORS:

Mop floors with a solution of 2 Tbsp. of EL PINOL T&R per gallon of water. In solution if desired.

TILE AND CEMENT:

Mop floors with 4 Tbsp. EL PINOL T&R per gallon of water.

NOTE: Rubber or asphalt tile, rinse immediately with water. Kitchen stoves, sinks, drainboards, refrigerators, etc. use 4 Tbsp. per gallon of water. For extra heavy greases, use 8 Tbsp. per gallon of water. For extra heavy greases, soak, rinse off. Treated food contact surfaces must be rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

GARBAGE PAILS: Use 2 Tbsp. EL PINOL T&R to 1 gallon of water.
