DIRECTIONS FOR CLEANING AND DEODORIZING

BATHROOM:

For wash basins, use ¼ cup EL PINOL per gallon of water. For bathtub and shower stalls—follow above directions. Add ¼ cup EL PINOL in the morning before flushing mop surface with full strength product.

WOOD FLOORS:

Mop floors with a solution of 1 cup of EL PINOL to 1 gallon of water.

TILE AND CEMENT:

Mop floors with ¼ cup EL PINOL to 1 gallon of water. Use

NOTE: Rubber or asphalt tile, rinse immediately with clear water.

Kitchen stoves, sinks, drainboards, refrigerators for ordinary cleaning of water. For extra heavy grease use ½ cup EL PINOL and ½ cup of water. For food contact surface must be thoroughly scrubbed with detergent to reuse.

FOR LAUNDRY:

(Cleaning and deodorizing): Add ½ cup, EL PINOL per load for top loading machines, or ¼ cup for front loading machines along with soap or ½ cup EL PINOL per gallon of water.

FOR STUBBORN STAINS: To remove bad stains (grease or grime) before laundry in full strength EL PINOL for a few minutes before laundering.

SOFTENS PAINT BRUSHES: Works on paint brushes, even those stiffened in full strength EL PINOL a few hours or overnight. Turns stiff brushes soft.

GARBAGE PAILS: Use full strength and allow to stand for at least 10 minutes.
