The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

Proposed Amendment

- Update First Aid Statement per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. Revise the Precautionary statements by including the signal word "Warning" immediately preceding the statement "Causes substantial, but temporary eye injury."
2. Revise the Storage and Disposal section by placing the statement "Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal." directly following the heading "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL."

3. Revise the If Swallowed section to read:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

4. Revise the If On Skin section to read:

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

5. Revise the First Aid Statements by including the statement "Have the product container or label with you when call a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment."

FOR STUBBORN STAINS: (grime) before laundering, soak stain in 19.9 for a few minutes before laundering. **SOFTENS PAINT BRUSHES:** Wash stiffened from oil based paints. Soak for a few hours or over night. Turns stiff.

Remove heavy soil or gross filth; the application of product 2.5 ounces per gallon of water on sponge and let stand for 10 minutes.

BATHROOM: For washbasins, tubs, and showers, mop with clear water, mop then rinse with clear water, follow above directions. Add ¼ cup of product to 1 gallon of water. Rinse at night, in the morning before flushing toilet.

WOOD FLOORS: Mop floors with 19.9 to 1 gallon of water. Use soap and water. **TILE AND CEMENT:** Mop floors with 19.9 to 1 gallon of water. Use soap in solution.

NOTE: Rubber or asphalt tile, rinse immediately.

Kitchen stoves, sinks, drain boards use ¼ cup of EL PINOL 19.9 per gallon of water. For grease, use ½ cup EL PINOL 19.9 per gallon of water. Treated food contact surfaces must be cleaned with detergent and rinsed with potable water.

LAUNDRY: (Cleaning and deodorizing) use ¼ cup of EL PINOL 19.9 per load for top loading machines (front loading machines use ½ cup) along with soap or detergent. When used on clothes, use ¼ cup of EL PINOL 19.9 per gallon of water.

GARBAGE PAILS: Use full amount of product, let stand for 10 minutes, and then rinse with water.
