The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registrations under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable.

Stamped copies of the labels are enclosed for your records.

It should be noted that the master name of record for EPA registration Number 11678-20 is "Diazol Diazinon - 8 Lbs. per Gallon Oil Concentrate (Stabilized)". While the Agency does not normally accept labeling with product names at variance from the master name of record, there appears to have been some confusion over the years as to the actual name of this product. As initially accepted in 1973, the product was called "Diazinon - 8 Lbs. per Gallon Oil Concentrate". The word "Diazol" appeared on the label but not on your application or the Notice of Registration. Your company requested addition of the word "stabilized" in 1973 and the Agency accepted "Diazol Diazinon - 8 Lbs. per Gallon Oil Concentrate (Stabilized)" at that time. In 1975 your company submitted updated labeling using the correct name on the correspondence but the name appeared as "Diazol Stabilized Oil Concentrate Diazinon 8 Lbs. Per Gallon" on the submitted labeling. This discrepancy was apparently not noticed and the label was stamped accepted in 1976 even though the Agency's letter used the correct master name (not the name appearing on the label). Your cover letter for the current submission shows the product name as "Diazol (Diazinon) Stabilized Oil Concentrate" [not mentioning the phrase "8 Lbs. Per Gallon"], while the submitted labeling bears the name "Diazol Stabilized Oil Concentrate 8 Lbs. Per Gallon [without the word "Diazinon"].

If your company intends to revise the master name of record at this time to match that appearing on the latest label (eliminating the word Diazinon), then you should submit an application requesting a change in the master product name of record. Otherwise, please add the word Diazinon, in the correct location, to future printings and submit five copies for our records. Please let us know of your decision soon so that this matter can be resolved before submission of labeling that will have to be made in response to the upcoming Diazinon Registration Standard. Likewise, please note for future correspondence and labeling that the master name of record for EPA reg. No. 11678-6 is "Diazol Diazinon Technical (Stabilized)".
