STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED - Remove from contaminated area and have patient lie down and keep quiet. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN - Remove contaminated clothing and wash skin immediately with soap and warm water. Get medical attention.

IF IN EYES - Wash with flowing water for at least 15 minutes.

DANGER

Poisonous if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Causes skin burns and irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Azinphos Methyl is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Patient should be kept under observation for 48 hours. Atropine is antidotal. Give 4 mg intramuscularly or intravenously. Repeat every 15 minutes until patient is fully atropinized. If cyanotic give artificial respiration. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to wildlife. Do not discharge into lakes, ponds or public water except in accordance with a NPDES permit. For further guidance, contact the nearest EPA Regional Office.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not store in front of space heater. Do not store in draft from an open door. Keep away from open flame. Do not heat. Store below 120°F. Do not store adjacent to toys, cosmetics, dishes, furniture or clothing. Do not store next to herbicides.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For the manufacture of insecticides only. Formulation of this product into a product labelled for use on sugarcane in Louisiana, or into any product which allows further formulation into a product labelled for use on sugarcane in Louisiana is prohibited. Cannot be used to formulate products with forestry uses.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
