POTATO SEED-PIECE TREATMENT

Aids in the suppression of Fusarium seed-piece decay, the most common seed-and soil-borne fungus disease of potatoes.

Aids in the protection of seed which is held for planting.

NOTICE: P.O.T. 6 will not control bacterial decay such as blackleg and soft rot or diseases present within the seed.

Dosage and Application: Use 1 lb. of effective ingredient dust per 100 lbs. of cut seed piece. Apply it so that the entire surface of the seed-piece is thoroughly covered by the fungicide dust. Place treated seed in clean, disease-free containers or store in bulk at proper temperature and humidity. Prevent inhalation of dust by use of exhaust fans during treatment.

Cutting and Treating: Before planting, cutting machines, knives, trays, tables, barrels or sacks, equipment, trucks and planters should be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized. If not sprouted, subject seed potatoes to temperatures of 50 degrees to 60 degrees F. for about 10 to 15 days before handling them.

The cut and treated seed may be planted immediately. If planting is delayed, follow the recommended storage practices of cut seed pieces in your area.

NOTICE: Tuber damage and/or decay may occur on sandy soils under moist soil conditions and higher than normal soil temperatures. Do not use if these conditions occur or if there has been any past history of seed piece decay due to this product. Not for use in Jefferson County, Idaho.

DO NOT USE TREATED SEED FOR FEED OR FOOD

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place. Avoid contact with moisture.

DISPOSAL: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by incineration, or if allowed by State and local authorities, by burning. If burned stay out of smoke.
